Suitable for acrylic, oil, watercolor, and other painting mediums.*

Start in the first row: mix the left color with each top color from left to right (e.g., Yellow + Red, then Yellow + Pink, etc.). Paint the result into the matching square. Move down to the next row and repeat the same process left to right.

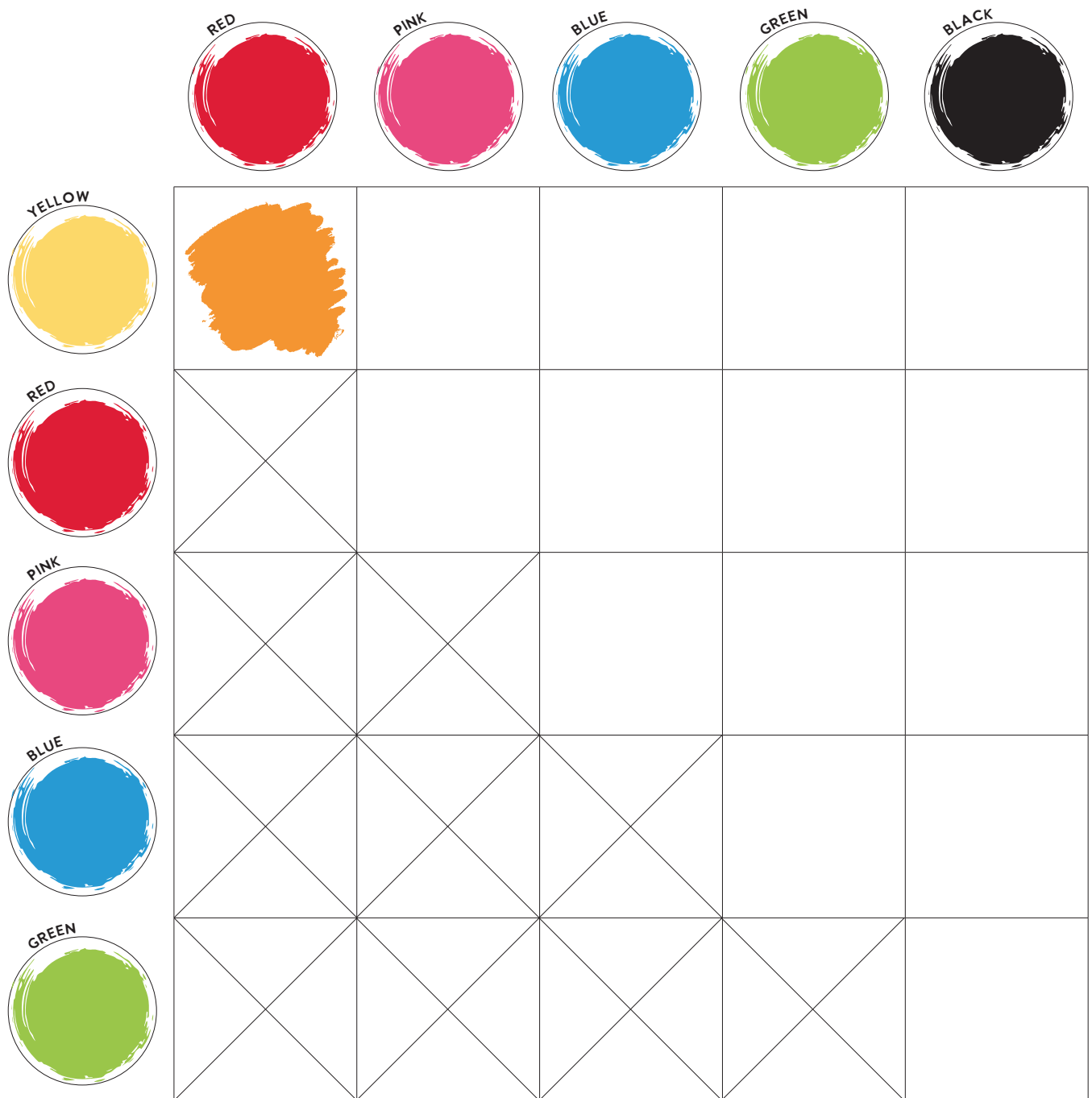
